The primary changes in this edition of Rabbit Nutrition and Nutritional Healing are in the chapters specifically about diet (chapters 6 and 10), although there are minor changes and additions throughout the book. I have added topics to chapter six, and have rewritten chapter ten to be less technical.

Rabbit Nutrition and Nutritional Healing - Don't Dump Rabbits

Legumes, such as alfalfa, are rich in potassium, and most grains are good sources of potassium, so deficiencies in rabbits are rare. Practical dietary recommendations fall between 6.5 and 10 g/kg. Sodium requirements have not been studied in the rabbit, but practical recommendations are 6.5 to 10 g/kg.

The Nutrition of the Rabbit - RabWay

In this invited communication the author proposes a list of nutritional recommendations for rabbits of different categories: growing from 18 to 42 days, from 42 to 80 days, for breeding does according to productivity (40-50 kits weaned per doe/year or more than 50) and for a single diet suitable for all rabbits. Recommendations taking account the last published data, are divided in 2 groups.
