Silvicultural systems and regeneration methods: current

A silvicultural system is a planned series of treatments for tending, harvesting and reestablishing a forest stand.1 "Forest management" is a broader term that includes biological, social and economic factors. For the forest owner, the terms may be interchangeable when a forest management plan is developed.
